SUMMARY

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Monitors and reports changes or concerns in animal health or behavior to shelter management and Staff Veterinarians as necessary.
- Clean, sanitize, and disinfect animal living environments to ensure overall animal health and comfort.
- Administers vaccinations and treatments for healthy, sick, and injured animals as necessary.
- Follows proper safety protocols for people and animals and sets a high standard for quality animal handling.
- Animal handling and restraint for examinations, sedation, diagnostics as directed by Veterinarian or Registered Veterinary Technicians.
- Assists Registered Veterinary Technician(s) in the Animal Support Center.
- Assists with euthanasia in a secondary capacity as necessary.
- Performs other duties and special projects as assigned by the Staff Veterinarian and Registered Veterinary Technician Supervisor.
